GNCC Returns to Snowshoe Mountain

The Motorcycle-USA.com Snowshoe GNCC is one stop on the nation's largest and most prestigious AMA/ATV sanctioned racing circuit. Now in it's third year, the Snowshoe stop, June 25-27, attracts the best off-road riders in the world! The GNCC series is America's largest off-road racing series for dirt bikes and ATVs, and the Snowshoe race is the toughest and most prestigious on the circuit, having been given the nickname, "America's Toughest Race". More than 1500 racers are expected to tackle the roots, rocks, hill climbs and mud found across the trails of Snowshoe. Fans can take the ski chair lifts up and down the mountain to catch the action and several viewing spots can be found throughout the course.

There will be a \$50,000 cash purse on the line for the riders who best negotiate the course. Competitors are expected to travel from Europe, Australia, Japan and South Africa in attempts to win the BIG prize! Amateur classes will compete as well, with classes for beginners, women and youth riders .

The NRAO (National Radio Astronomy Observatory) is located just a few miles from Snowshoe Mountain. It is the world's largest, steerable radio telescope. Scientists from around the world use the Green Bank Telescope to study virtually all types of astronomical objects known, from planets and comets in our own Solar System to quasars and galaxies from billions of light-years away.
