



Q: Will there be tables and chairs?

A: Tables and chairs will be limited, please bring your own lawn chairs or blankets.

Q: What if my credit card was declined, am I registered and eligible to win?

A: No, if your credit card was declined or your check was returned for non sufficient funds, you are not registered and therefore not eligible for the Treasure on the Mountain Raffle prizes.

Q: Is Smoking or Drinking Allowed?

A: Smoking is allowed on the raffle grounds. Beverage gardens will be set up in legal proximity to the raffle grounds. Please note: No glass containers allowed on the raffle grounds.

Q: Do I need to be present for the drawing?

A: No, you will be notified if you have won via email and/or phone by August 11, 2010. If you did not provide a phone number or email address on your ticket stub, you will be notified by USPS.

Q: Will the results be posted on the Internet?

A: Yes, the unofficial list of winners will be posted on the website at www.snowshoefoundation.com as the numbers are drawn. Official results will be posted within 3 business days proceeding the dispute period deadline of August 11, 2010.

Q: Where do I collect Firearms?

A: All firearms will be picked up at Valley Trading Post in Valley Bend, WV. All firearm winners will be subject to a background check. Firearms will not be available the day of the event. Valley Trading Post telephone number is 304-338-4325.

Q: Do I have an option if I don't want or can not take possession of a firearm?



A: Yes, you have the option to receive cash as your prize equal to 50% of the recommended dealer's MSRP.

Q: Where do I collect my automobile or ATV?

A: Once you are notified that you are a winner, you will be provided with the location of where to pick up your vehicle, ATV, etc. All suppliers of vehicles, motorcycles and ATV's are located within a 200 mile radius of Snowshoe Mountain, West Virginia. All expenses to pick up your prize are the responsibility of the winner. Original signatures are required on W9's or W2G's in advance of picking up or receiving any prize.

Q: How long do I have to collect my prize?

A: You have **15 days**, from the posting of the Officials Results. Official results will be available three days preceding the dispute date of August 11, 2010.

Q: Is camping available?

A: Camping is available at Whitaker Campground in Cass, WV 1-304-456-3218; Watoga State Park Campground in Seebert, WV 1-304-653-4509. Limited RV parking is available at Silver Creek by calling 1-877--441-4386.

Q: What is the dress for the Treasure on the Mountain event?

A: The Treasure on the Mountain event is an outdoor event on a ski slope so, casual dress is recommended. Please check the weather forecast prior to arrival and dress appropriately.

Q: What is the location of the Raffle Grounds?

A: Raffle grounds are on Skidder Slope, adjacent to the Village at Snowshoe Mountain. Bring Lawn Chairs and/or blankets for seating.

Q: Will there be food and drinks?

A: Food and non alcoholic beverages will be available free of charge on the raffle grounds to Ticket holders and their guests by showing an entrance wrist band.

Q: Will side raffles be offered the day of the event on the Raffle Grounds?

A: Yes, side raffles and 50/50's will be available on the Raffle Grounds.

Q: Are children permitted on the Raffle Grounds?

A: No one under the age of 18 is permitted on the Raffle Grounds, this includes food vendor staffing.

Q: How do I claim a prize?

A: To claim your prize at the event - go to the procurement tent. At that time you will be asked to produce your ticket stub and to provide identification. If you are not present, you will be notified of your win and you will have 15 days to claim your prize by either calling (304) 572-8500 or sending an email to Treasure@snowshoemtn.com.

Q: Is weather a factor in holding the event?

A: No, the event will be held rain or shine, however there may be delays.

Q: Will tickets will be available the day of the event?



A: Any unsold Tickets will be available on the day of the event at the main entrance of the raffle grounds.

Q: When is the deadline for online ticket purchases?

A. Any remaining tickets may be purchased online until August 5, 2010 midnight. All Tickets purchased after July 30th, will be available for pickup at the ticket sales tent at the main entrance to the raffle grounds.

Q: When is the deadline for phone and email orders?

Phone and email orders will be taken until tickets are sold out up to and on the day of the event; however sales will not be finalized until any credit card charges or checks have been cleared. All Tickets purchased by phone or email after July 30th, will be available for pickup at the ticket sales tent by the main entrance to the raffle grounds.

Q: Are Treasure on the Mountain Ticket holders and guests permitted on and off the Raffle Grounds?

A: Yes, your wrist band will allow you to move around the resort freely.

Q: Will winning raffle numbers be announced?

A: Yes, Audio Speakers will be set up the raffle grounds and on the Village Stage along with a results board.

Q: Where can I find the Results Boards?

A: We will have two Results Boards; one will be located on the Raffle Grounds on Skidder Slope and one will be located on the Village Stage, Village Central, for your convenience.

Q: Are results official the day of the event?



A: No, Official Results will not be available until Aug 14th, 2010 preceding the deadline for disputes which must be in writing to treasure@snowshoemtn.com by August 11, 2010.

Q: How can I lodge a dispute?

Q: Am I limited to the number of guests that I can bring with me?

A: Yes, only one guest is permitted for each Treasure on the Mountain Ticket held. A \$25 guest fee is payable at entrance gate to the Raffle Grounds.
