As a condition of use of the ski area and other facilities, the ticket holder assumes all risk of personal injury, death or property loss resulting from any cause whatsoever including but not limited to: the risks, dangers and hazards of skiing, snowboarding, tubing, tobogganing, cycling, mountain biking, hiking and other recreational activities; the use of ski lifts, carpet lifts and tube tows; collision or impact with natural or man-made objects or with other persons; travel within or beyond the area boundaries; or negligence, breach of contract, or breach of statutory duty of care on the part of Blackcomb Skiing Enterprises Limited Partnership, Whistler Mountain Resort Limited Partnership, Intrawest ULC, Mountain Employment Company Ltd. and their employees, instructors, guides, agents, independent contractors, subcontractors, representatives, sponsors, successors and assigns (hereinafter collectively referred to as "Whistler Blackcomb"). The ticket holder agrees that Whistler Blackcomb shall not be liable for any such personal injury, death or property loss and releases Whistler Blackcomb and waives all claims with respect thereto. The ticket holder agrees that any litigation involving Whistler Blackcomb shall be brought solely within the Province of British Columbia and shall be within the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of the Province of British Columbia. The ticket holder further agrees that these conditions and any rights, duties and obligations as between Whistler Blackcomb and the ticket holder shall be governed by and interpreted solely in accordance with the laws of the Province of British Columbia and no other jurisdiction.
